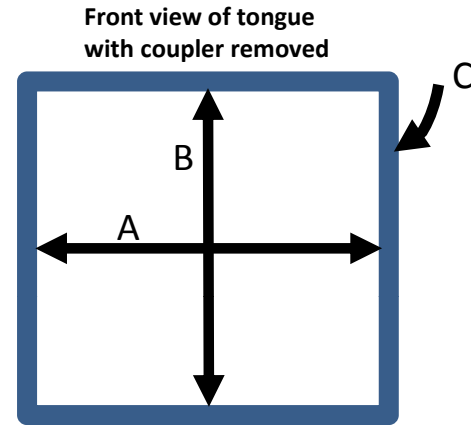


## Insuring the Right Swivel Adapter Fit

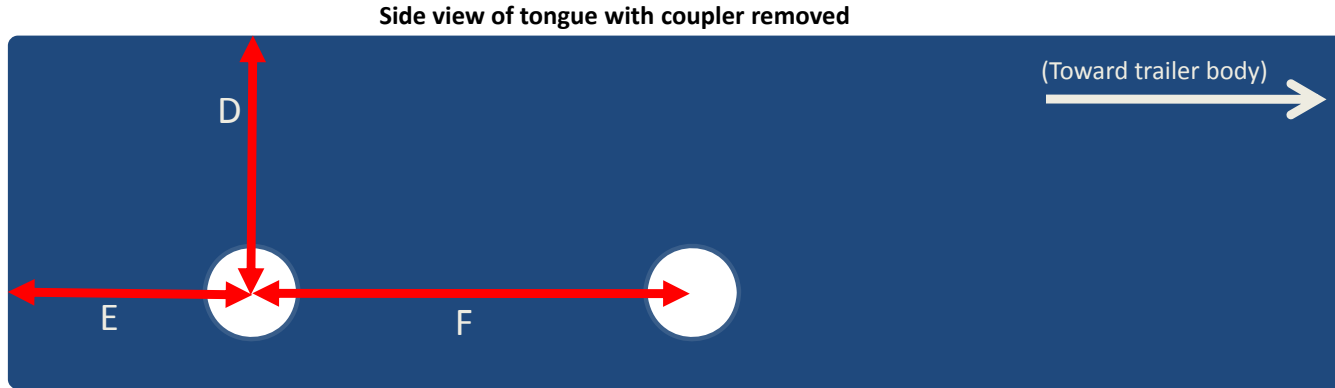
Trailer couplers are made by dozens of companies. Many fit common measurements, but if the coupler on your trailer is unmarked or an unknown brand, there's no way to be sure without first taking a few measures. Open Road created this template to help you identify what measurements to take when asked, so we can get you the right product.

In order to get the most accurate measurements, unbolt the coupler from the tongue, then fill in the following measurements, in inches:

- A) \_\_\_\_\_ (inside tongue width)
- B) \_\_\_\_\_ (inside tongue height)
- C) \_\_\_\_\_ (thickness of tongue material)
- D) \_\_\_\_\_ (distance from top to center of hole)
- E) \_\_\_\_\_ (distance from front edge to center of 1<sup>st</sup> hole)
- F) \_\_\_\_\_ (center to center distance between holes)



Note: If your tongue has a tongue that is 2.5" wide, the swivel kit we recommend will include a standard coupler and spacers.
